

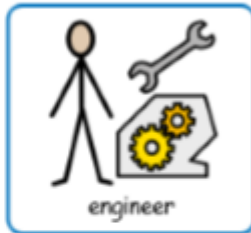


Year 1

They will learn to identify countries on a map of the world and use directions and locational language. They will link the real life adventures to the adventures of different story characters in English.

Key Knowledge

Children will:

- Know that Christopher Columbus was born in Italy and learnt to sail in a wooden ship with sails.
- Know that he learnt to find the way at sea by using the stars and the sun.
- Know that he had a dream to travel west and go to China and the Queen of Spain gave him money for ships.
- Know that Christopher Columbus started communication between Europe and America.
- Know that before he went to America no one in Europe had eaten a tomato or potato before!
- Know that Neil Armstrong was the first man to walk on the moon.
- Know that Neil Armstrong was 15 when he got his pilot's licence and flew over 200 types of aircraft.
- He became an astronaut and commanded the Apollo 11 spacecraft to the moon.
