Key Vocabulary

1	Pier	a platform on pillars projecting from the shore into the sea, typically incorporating entertainment arcades and places to eat.
2	Resort	A place that is frequented for holidays or recreation or for a particular purpose
3	Coast	The part of the land adjoining or near the sea
4	Urban	In, relating to, or characteristic of a town or city.
5	Rural	In, relating to, or characteristic of the countryside rather than the town.
6	Tourist	A person who is travelling or visiting a place for pleasure
7	Seaside	A place by the sea, especially a beach area or holiday resort
8	Vegetation	Plants considered collectively, especially those found in a particular area or habitat.
9	Promenade	A paved public walk, typically one along the seafront at a resort.
10	Harbour	A place on the coast where ships may moor in shelter, especially one protected from rough water by piers, jetties, and other artificial structures.
