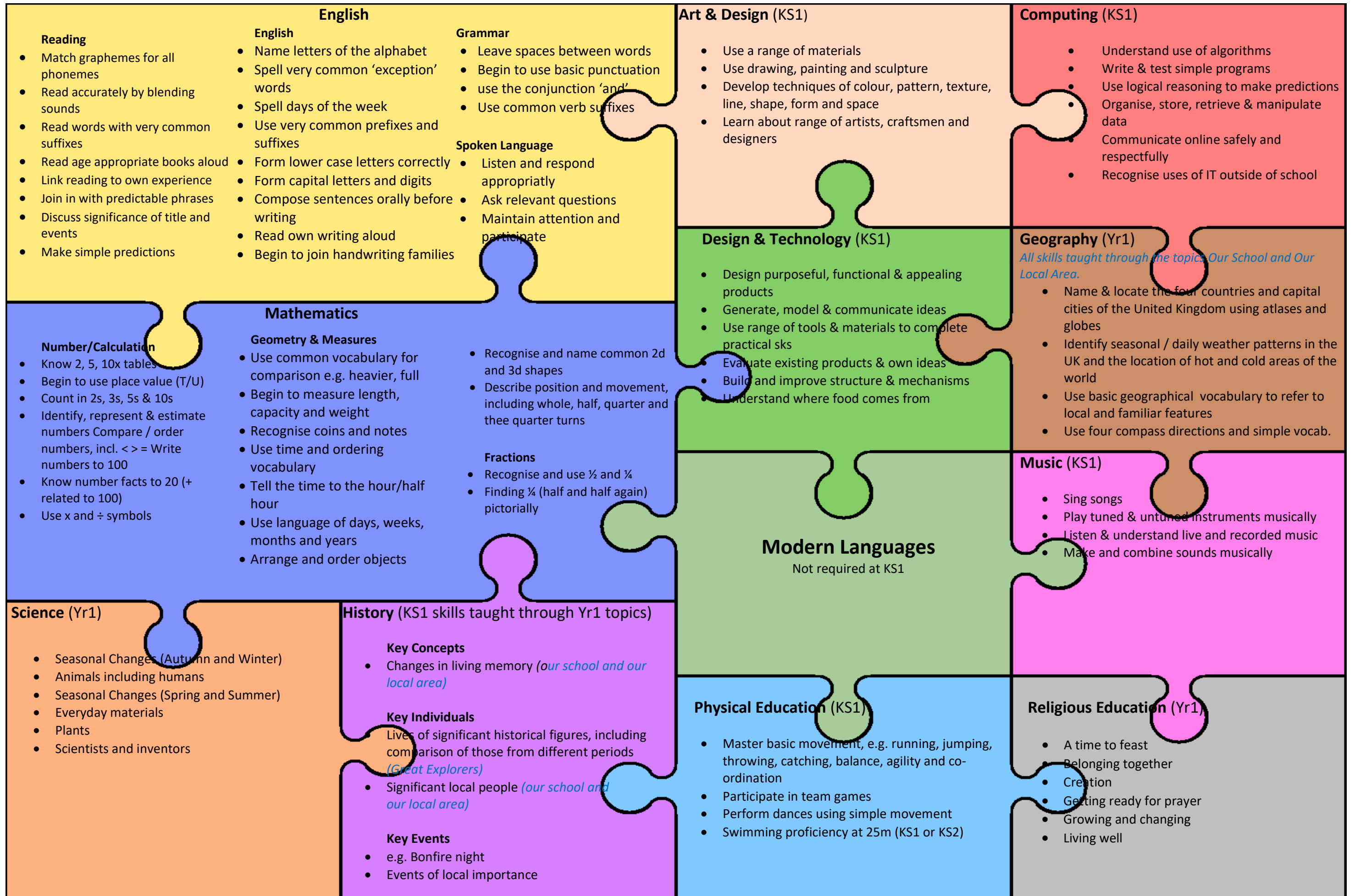


Curriculum Overview for Year 1 – 2017-2018



English

Reading

- Match graphemes for all phonemes
- Read accurately by blending sounds
- Read words with very common suffixes
- Read age appropriate books aloud
- Link reading to own experience
- Join in with predictable phrases
- Discuss significance of title and events
- Make simple predictions

English

- Name letters of the alphabet
- Spell very common 'exception' words
- Spell days of the week
- Use very common prefixes and suffixes
- Form lower case letters correctly
- Form capital letters and digits
- Compose sentences orally before writing
- Read own writing aloud
- Begin to join handwriting families

Grammar

- Leave spaces between words
- Begin to use basic punctuation
- use the conjunction 'and'
- Use common verb suffixes

Spoken Language

- Listen and respond appropriately
- Ask relevant questions
- Maintain attention and participate

Art & Design (KS1)

- Use a range of materials
- Use drawing, painting and sculpture
- Develop techniques of colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space
- Learn about range of artists, craftsmen and designers

Computing (KS1)

- Understand use of algorithms
- Write & test simple programs
- Use logical reasoning to make predictions
- Organise, store, retrieve & manipulate data
- Communicate online safely and respectfully
- Recognise uses of IT outside of school

Mathematics

Number/Calculation

- Know 2, 5, 10x tables
- Begin to use place value (T/U)
- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s & 10s
- Identify, represent & estimate numbers Compare / order numbers, incl. < > = Write numbers to 100
- Know number facts to 20 (+ related to 100)
- Use x and ÷ symbols

Geometry & Measures

- Use common vocabulary for comparison e.g. heavier, full
- Begin to measure length, capacity and weight
- Recognise coins and notes
- Use time and ordering vocabulary
- Tell the time to the hour/half hour
- Use language of days, weeks, months and years
- Arrange and order objects

Shapes

- Recognise and name common 2d and 3d shapes
- Describe position and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns

Fractions

- Recognise and use ½ and ¼
- Finding ¼ (half and half again) pictorially

Design & Technology (KS1)

- Design purposeful, functional & appealing products
- Generate, model & communicate ideas
- Use range of tools & materials to complete practical sks
- Evaluate existing products & own ideas
- Build and improve structure & mechanisms
- Understand where food comes from

Geography (Yr1)

All skills taught through the topics Our School and Our Local Area.

- Name & locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom using atlases and globes
- Identify seasonal / daily weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to local and familiar features
- Use four compass directions and simple vocab.

Science (Yr1)

- Seasonal Changes (Autumn and Winter)
- Animals including humans
- Seasonal Changes (Spring and Summer)
- Everyday materials
- Plants
- Scientists and inventors

History (KS1 skills taught through Yr1 topics)

Key Concepts

- Changes in living memory (*our school and our local area*)

Key Individuals

- Lives of significant historical figures, including comparison of those from different periods (*Great Explorers*)
- Significant local people (*our school and our local area*)

Key Events

- e.g. Bonfire night
- Events of local importance

Modern Languages

Not required at KS1

Music (KS1)

- Sing songs
- Play tuned & untuned instruments musically
- Listen & understand live and recorded music
- Make and combine sounds musically

Physical Education (KS1)

- Master basic movement, e.g. running, jumping, throwing, catching, balance, agility and co-ordination
- Participate in team games
- Perform dances using simple movement
- Swimming proficiency at 25m (KS1 or KS2)

- A time to feast
- Belonging together
- Creation
- Getting ready for prayer
- Growing and changing
