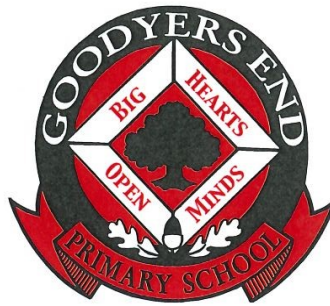

Roots to Branches, formerly the Get Together is a local charity which provides support and help in preventing isolation for those in Coventry and Warwickshire with a diagnosis of autism and their families.

They support young people and their families effected by autism or associated conditions, with organised support and information sessions. The sessions are open to the whole family and welcome families who are awaiting assessment for their child/ren also.

One way in which they offer support is by running support sessions where those diagnosed and their families can come to play and meet others in similar circumstances, the do not judge families or a child's behaviour. The parents and siblings are able to relax in an environment which is 'autism friendly' and the children get to experience like-minded individuals and none of the pressures that school and other groups have.
