

One way in which they offer support is by running support sessions where those diagnosed and their families can come to play and meet others in similar circumstances, the do not judge families or a child's behaviour. The parents and siblings are able to relax in an environment which is 'autism friendly' and the children get to experience like-minded individuals and none of the pressures that school and other groups have.
