Medication In School

Parents should not be sending any medication into school with children; this is a concern on many levels.

Medicines which have been prescribed by a doctor to be administered three times a day will not be given in school, as this medication can be given outside school hours.

Medication prescribed by a doctor to be given four times a day can be kept in school and staff will do their best to administer the medicine at the correct time **BUT** parents need to complete a medical form at the school office.

Any medication not prescribed (i.e. bought yourself from the chemist) cannot be administered - you will need to come into school at the time if your child needs it.

Please see our Medical Conditions Policy (available on our website) for further information on the administering of medication to pupils.

Any specific needs over and above these general guidelines should be discussed with the Headteacher.
