I would like to thank those of you, who do feel the need to raise a concern about their child, for approaching the school and going through the appropriate channels to address the issue. As pertinent an issue may be to you and your child, the issue should not be expressed in a way which upsets other children and parents, most of whom are totally unrelated to the incident. It is vital that you are considerate with your language and behaviour on school grounds – **you are the role models for our future adults.**

Whilst 'fall outs' between parents may not always be linked to school we still request you handle your dispute in a civilised manner.

Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated and I encourage anybody who feels threatened and/or intimidated to inform us **and** the police. I would also add that this advice goes wider than the school gate. We all have a duty of care to all our children; day and night, weekday or weekends.

I hope as a community we can work together to ensure children flourish and thrive in a happy and harmonious environment.
