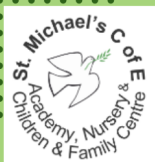
REQUEST

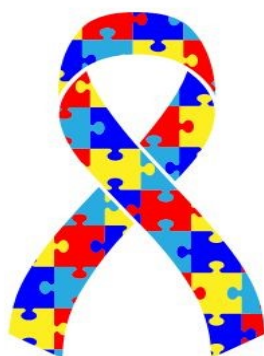
