SCHOOL UNIFORM

Wearing a school uniform promotes a sense of belonging to our school. Red sweatshirts, cardigans and fleeces with the school logo are available from Match Fit Kit Schoolwear in Nuneaton (www.matchfitkit.com).

We sell second hand uniform at extremely reasonable prices and you are also welcome to purchase uniform without logos as sold in most high street stores.

Winter:

white blouse or shirt white or red polo shirt grey or black skirt or trousers red jumper, cardigan or sweatshirt



Summer - as above or:

red and white striped or checked dresses black or grey short trousers

All children are asked to wear black sensible shoes for school (not trainers). All accessories such as tights/socks should be in keeping with the school uniform colours.

Please name all clothing to help us return all lost items to their rightful owner.

Jewellery

For safety reasons, jewellery should not be worn in school. We do allow children to wear a watch and <u>one small stud</u> in each ear but these will need to be removed or covered for swimming and PE lessons. We also respect that some children may need to wear a piece of jewellery for religious reasons.

PE Kit:

For safety and hygiene reasons children will need to wear their PE kit to school on their designated PE day:

black shorts
red T-shirt
black slip-on pumps for indoor lessons
outdoor trainers for games' lessons
tracksuit or similar in KS2 for winter sports






