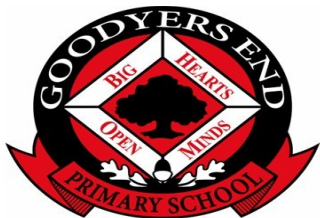

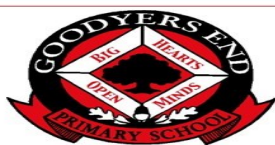




PRE-LOVED SCHOOL UNIFORM SALE DURING SUMMER HOLIDAYS
