Monday Science	<p><u>National Insect Week – Nature Walk</u> Looking in your garden or out on a walk, I want you to investigate the different types of insects that you see. Use these questions to guide your investigation and report your findings back to your teacher. You may also want to take pictures to show what you have found.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do more insects (invertebrates) live in the shady areas or the sunny areas? • Are they in more grassy areas or on the pavement? • Do you notice what types of insects live in or on trees? • Which insects do you see on flowers? • Which insect did you notice the most whilst you were looking?
Tuesday DT	<p><u>National Insect Week – Make a Bug Hotel</u> https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Smv_9vgN39A Using the link, have a go at making your own bug hotel. Once you have created it, keep it in an outdoor area and continue to check on it and see if you discover any more bugs (after yesterday's investigation). You will need a plastic bottle and any sticks, grass, soil etc. that you find outside. Send a picture to your teacher to show them your creation.</p>
