



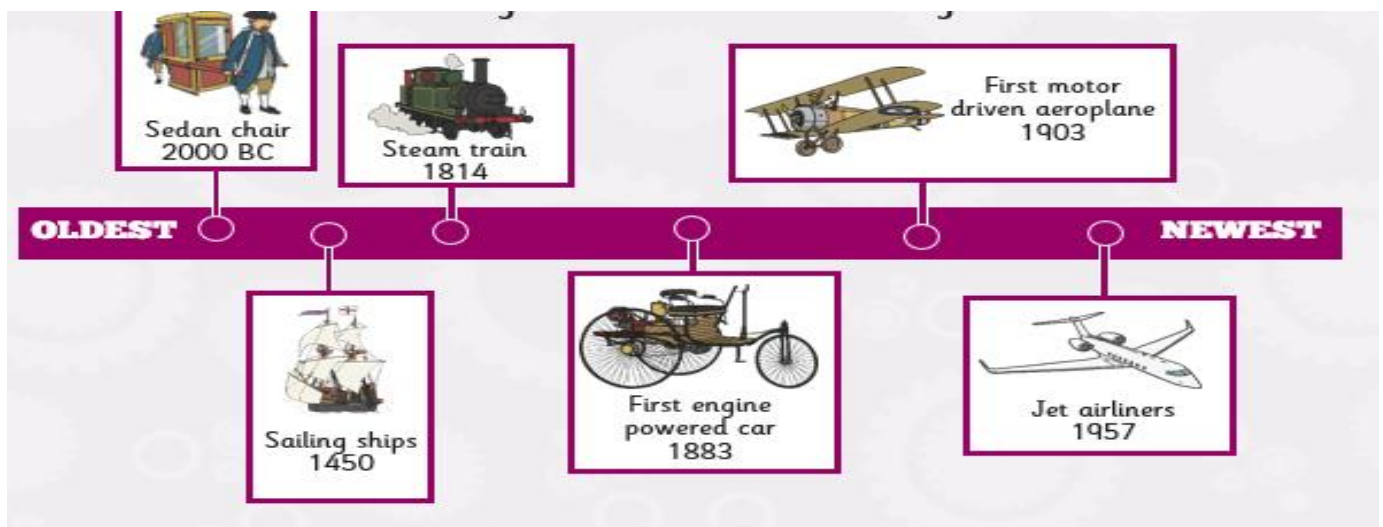
Travel and Transport

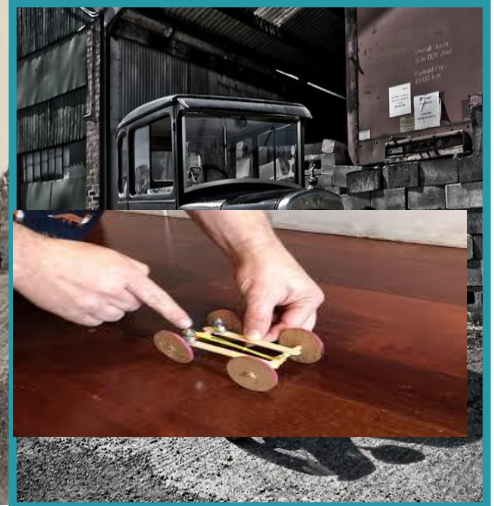
Key Vocabulary

1	Travel	Make a journey, typically of some length
2	Transport	Take or carry (people or goods) from one place to another by means of a vehicle, aircraft, or ship
3	Penny farthing	An early type of bicycle, made in Britain, with a very large front wheel and a small rear wheel
4	Sedan chair	An enclosed chair for conveying one person, carried between horizontal poles by two porters.
5	Engine	A machine with moving parts that converts power into motion.
6	Steam train	A train that is powered by a steam engine.
7	Viking long boat	A medieval ship used in northern Europe especially by the Norse , having a long , narrow, open hull, a single square sail , and a large number of oars, which provided most of the propulsion.
8	Petrol	A light fuel oil that is obtained by distilling petroleum and used in internal combustion engines
9	Diesel	An internal combustion engine in which heat produced by the compression of air in the cylinder is used to ignite the fuel
10	Future	A period of time following the moment of speaking or writing; time regarded as still to come.
